Inaccessible - Unable to access property

IE: Bridge out leading to property

Affected

- Minimal damage to the exterior of the home and non-essential basement

• Ingress / Egress to residence may be hampered

• Some shingles and/or sidingmissing

• Dwelling is livable without repairs

• IE: Stone driveway is washed away due to heavy rains

Minor

- Damage that does not affect the structural integrity

Property is damaged, butusableDamage to chimney, windows

• IE: Roofing shingles blown off due to high winds,

Major

- Significant structural damage and requires extensive repairs

• Structure cannot be used until repairs are made

• IE: Roof blown off due to high winds, failure or partial failure of foundation

Destroyed

- Property is no longerthere

• Repairs to structure not feasible
